



## Pinelands-Friendly Yard & Garden Fair, September 25

Come to the **3rd Annual Pinelands-Friendly Yard & Garden Fair** at [Woodford Cedar Run Wildlife Refuge](#) on Saturday, September 25 from 11am - 4pm. The event will focus on native plant and animal species of the New Jersey Pinelands.

Attendees will learn how they can take action in their own yards to help protect the unique environment of the **1.1.-million-acre Pinelands National Reserve** in southern New Jersey, and learn how to protect our native pollinators, plants, habitats and wildlife!

The festival will feature:

- **Native Plant Sale: Rare Find Nursery, Earth First Native Plant Nursery, Pinelands Nursery will be on-hand to sell approximately 70 different species of native Pinelands plants.**
- **Demonstrations** about rain barrels, rain gardens and how to create ecological sensitive landscapes
- **Presentations** by Carole Brown of [EcoSystem Gardening](#) and John Black, Master Naturalist of [Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge](#)
- **Exhibitors** will include: Rutgers University Coop Extension; [the Burlington County Master Gardeners](#), [Pinelands Preservation Alliance](#), [Burlington County Dept. of Resource Conservation](#), and [New Jersey Audubon](#).
- **Guided Nature Walks**

- A **live Wildlife Show** with a focus on habitat, including a red-tailed hawk, barred owl, screech owl, American kestrel, Pine Snake and others. (A Raptor Show will take place at approx. 1 p.m.)
